

Cookie statement

What is a cookie?

Our website uses cookies. Cookies are simple small text files that are placed on (the IP address of) your computer via this website and that register information about your visit to the website. Your browser stores the cookie on your computer's hard drive. The information stored therein can be sent back to our servers on a subsequent visit. Cookies cannot damage the files on your computer.

Functional cookies

Functional cookies are necessary for the website to function properly. With the help of a functional cookie we can recognize you when you visit our website again. The website can therefore be specially adjusted to your preferences. Even if you have given permission to place cookies, we can remember this by means of a cookie. This way, you don't have to keep repeating your preferences, which saves you time and allows you to use our website more pleasantly.

Analytical cookies

Analytical cookies are used to see which parts of the website you have viewed during this visit. In this way we can adapt our service(s) as much as possible to the surfing behavior of our visitors. These cookies are automatically deleted as soon as you close your web browser.

Social networks

Our website may include buttons to promote ("like") or share ("tweet") web pages on social networks such as Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn. The buttons work using pieces of code that come from Facebook, Twitter or LinkedIn themselves. Cookies are placed with this code. We have no influence on that. Therefore, read the privacy statement of Facebook, Twitter or LinkedIn (which can change regularly) to read what they do with your (personal) data that they process via these cookies.

The information that these parties collect is anonymized as much as possible. The information is transferred to and by Twitter, Facebook, Google + and LinkedIn and stored on servers in the United States. LinkedIn, Twitter, Facebook and Google+ state that they adhere to the Privacy Shield principles and are affiliated with the Privacy Shield program of the US Department of Commerce. In this way, there is an appropriate level of protection for the processing of any personal data.

Right to view and correct or delete your data

You have the right to request access to and correction or deletion of your data. You can find our contact details on our contact page. To prevent abuse, we may ask you to identify yourself. If you want to view personal data linked to a cookie, we ask you to send a copy of the cookie in question. You can find this in the settings of your browser.

Enabling and disabling cookies and their removal

The easiest way to delete the cookies is via your browser. More information about enabling, disabling and deleting cookies can be found in the instructions and / or using the Help function of your browser.
